AIR FRYER EGG BITES

Anything you can put in an oven you can put in an air fryer. I love the silicone muffin cups. I found them at Bed Bath & Beyond but I am sure you can find them online.

These air fryer egg bites can be so customizable depending on what you have on hand veggie wise. I used a spicy salsa so I didn't need any additional seasoning, but you can adjust to what you have on hand.

For four egg bites (2 servings)

1 cup fresh spinach, chopped

4 tablespoons salsa

4 eggs

1 ounce cheddar cheese, divided

Heat air fryer to 360 for 5 minutes.

Spray silicone molds with avocado oil spray. Divide the spinach on the bottom of each cup. Add 1 tablespoon salsa, and one cracked egg into each cup, (I scrambled once in the cup because I don't like a runny egg) then divide the cheese over each one.

Bake at 360 for 8 minutes. Let cool 2 minutes before removing. Love that it makes two servings. I simply reheat at 360 for 4 minutes to eat breakfast another day.
